When I was little, we traveled thirty-something miles to attend church every Sunday back to the church where my parents, grandparents, great-grandparents, great-great-grandparents (and even further back on several branches of the family tree) had worshipped for over a hundred years. As we rode, we listened to a radio station that played gospel music---the same songs in the same order every Sunday. I could tell by the song and where we were if we would have time for breakfast at Grandmother's or if we would have to wait until after church to eat. One of the songs was "Without Him." The verse referred to a person without Jesus as being a ship without a sail. If I miss a Sunday in church, by the next Sunday, I have begun to feel like a ship without a sail. I personally need to be in corporate worship every week.

I have been truly fortunate during this pandemic because I have been able to be in worship every week. While not the normal worship I have enjoyed all my life, still I have had the opportunity to be in God's House with other Christians. It worries me to think that some of my First Methodist Family may be sailing through the weeks without the pleasure of dropping anchor and joining in face-to-face worship. Please know that there is plenty of room to come to church and safely social distance; hand sanitizer and masks are readily available. Watching the service online or on TV is great—but it is not quite like being in our beautiful sanctuary with our church family.
